



Seagrove sustains excellence

CONSTRUCTION has started on the two newest parks at Seagrove Phillip Island, an environmentally sensitive residential estate in Cowes.

The parks, which cover more than 1.5 ha, include a children's playground, solar-powered barbecues and a eucalypt woodland.

The site is less than 700m from the beach and walking distance from cafes and restaurants.

Seagrove was recognised in the Environmental Excellence category at the 2007 Urban Development Institute of Australia Awards for Excellence.

The judges commended Seagrove for "setting a new benchmark for sustainable residential development".
